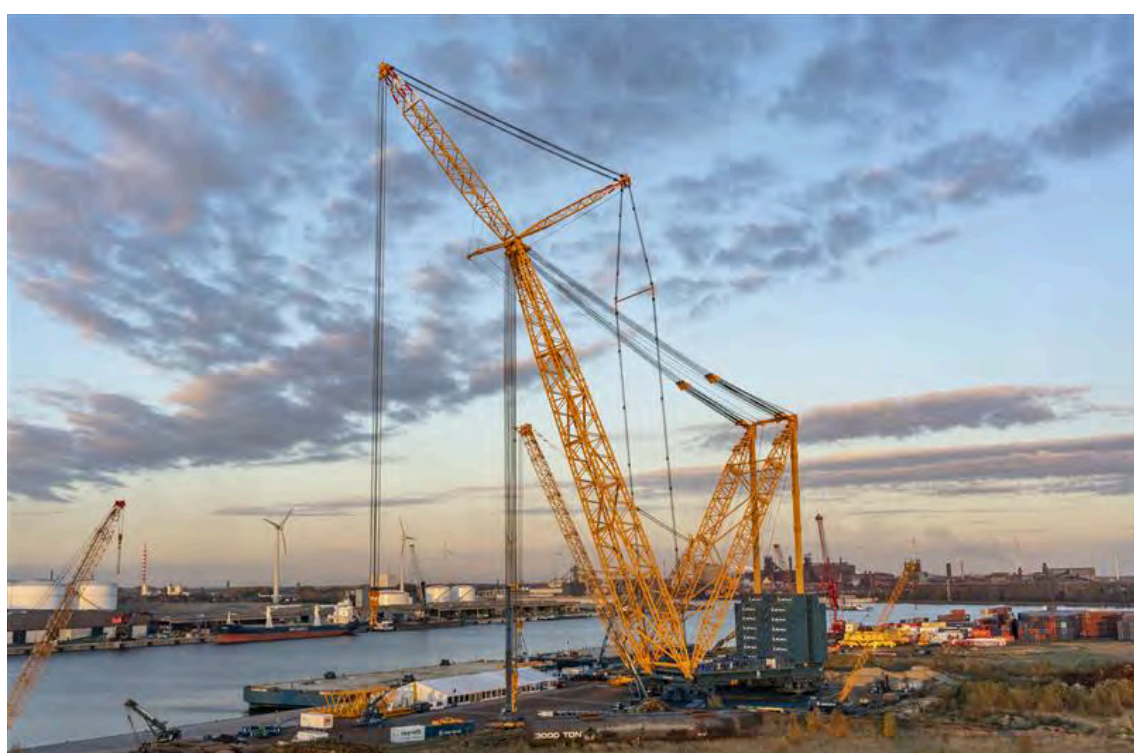

over the Albert Canal. The bridge is intended to improve sustainable road connections for both pedestrians and cyclists.

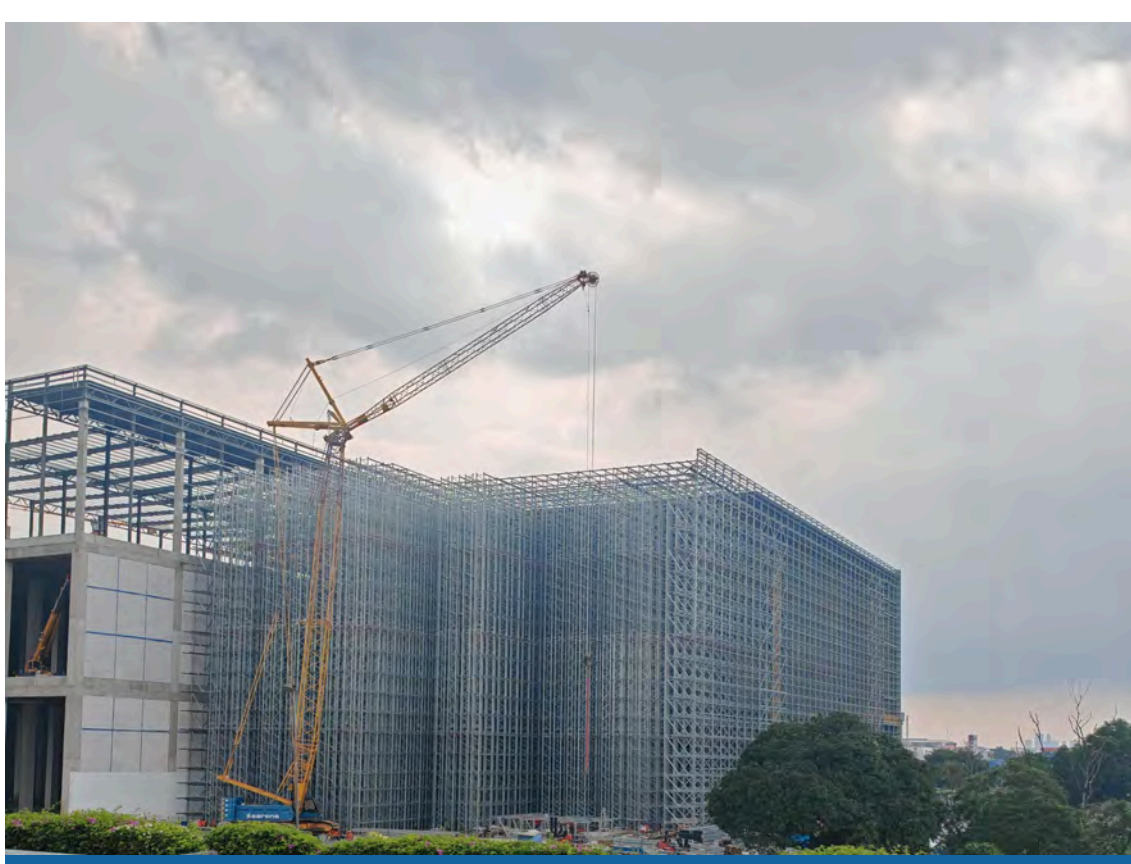

Sarens Completes Transport and Installation of Buda Bridge in Brussels

In a significant project that has restored a critical infrastructure element, Sarens successfully completed the transport and installation of the Buda Bridge in Brussels. Sarens partnered with HYE and the operational teams of the Port of Brussels to execute the complex logistics required for the bridge's restoration. The operation took place in two parts that involved the use of the Josef-Rosa twin barge, the Karel-Viktor twin barge, 16 axle lines of Self-Propelled Modular Transporters (SPMTs), and a sophisticated jacking system to remove the entire bridge, and lift and position the new bridge structure accurately.

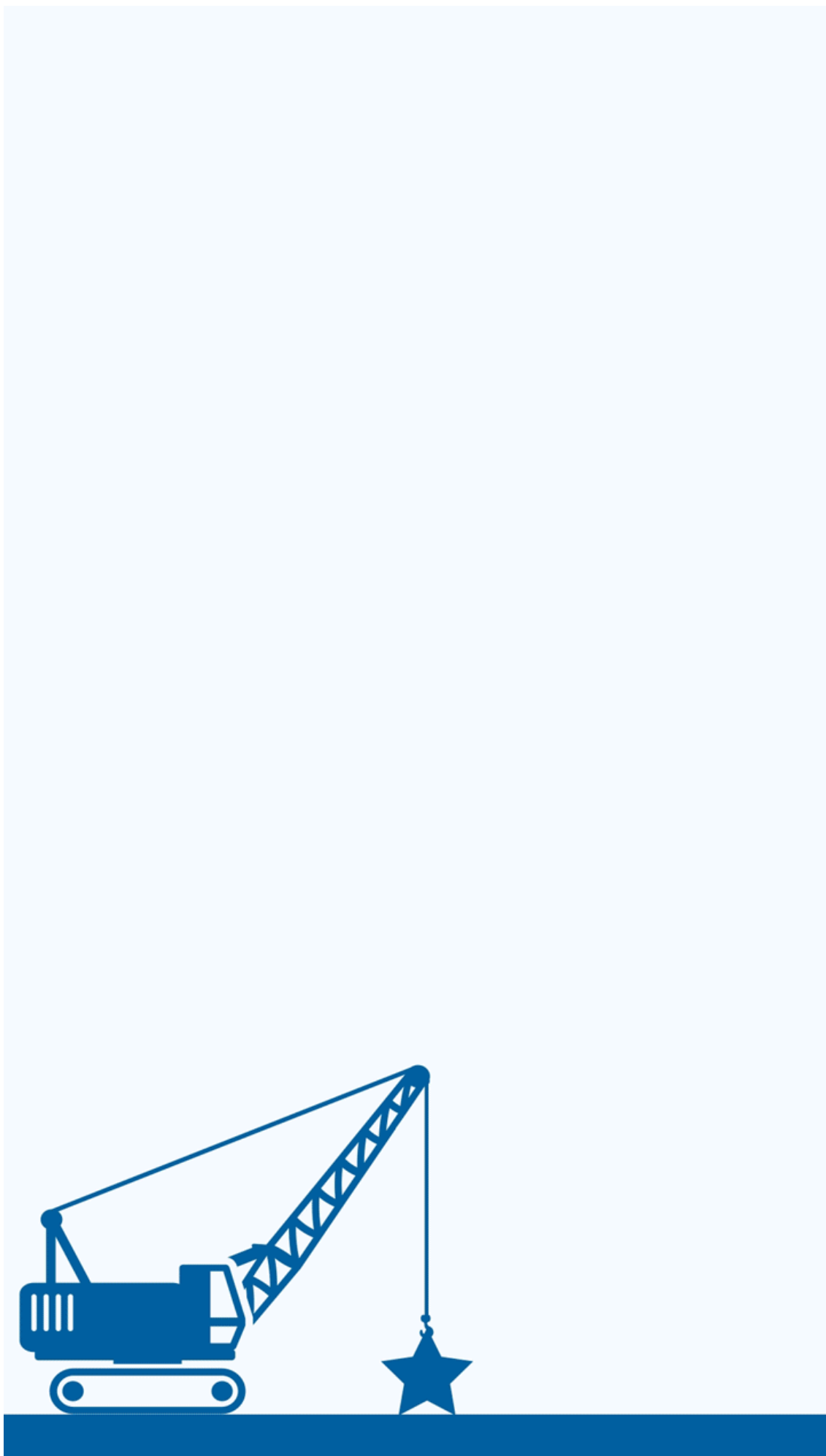
